Feature Extraction and Segmentation are the last phases in the process of classification.

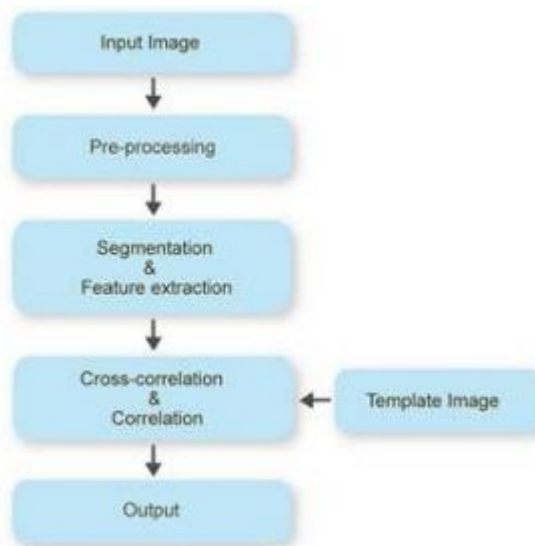
Step 5: It is important to classify and post-process the information.

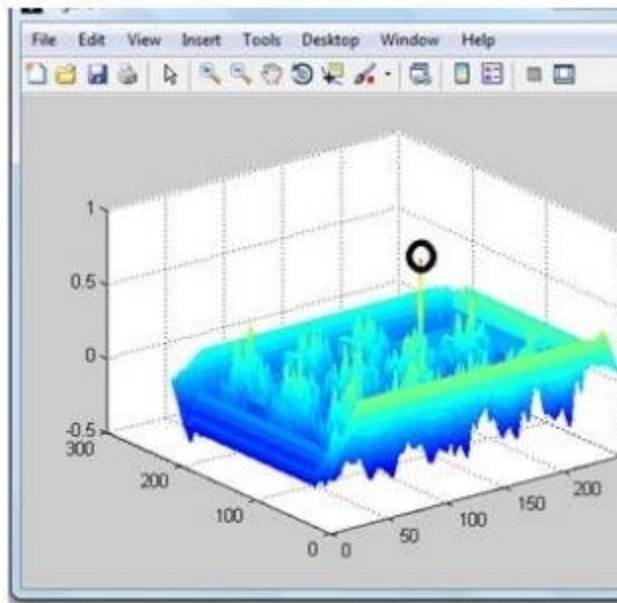


Figure 9: Marked Peak in cross correlation refer Character Detection

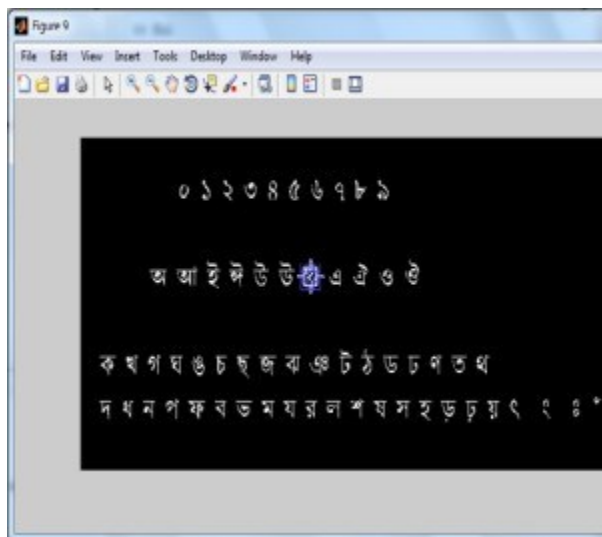


Figure 10: Recognized character from Template.
